Firework Regulations

Regulations:

Sales and Distribution Prohibited. The City of Edgewood prohibits the sale and distribution of fireworks. It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to engage in the retail sale of fireworks.

Dangerous Fireworks Prohibited. No one shall possess, use or explode any fireworks other than “Safe and Sane” Consumer Fireworks as defined in RCW 70.77.136.

Approved Discharge Dates and Times:

You may use or explode fireworks in the City each day from July 1st to July 5th, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 11:00pm. On July 4th the period of discharge is extended until 12:00am midnight. Any person found in violation will be subject to penalties and fines as defined in Edgewood Municipal Code Section 8.10.

Safety Tips:

- Do not let children light fireworks, designate a responsible adult. (Remember, even sparklers can burn at temperatures of 1800 degrees!)
- Keep fireworks away from anything that can burn such as trees, buildings or dry grassy fields.
- Never hold or throw fireworks.
- Keep pets indoors with doors and windows shut.
- Dispose of used fireworks and duds in a trash can with water. If a device does not light or fire, leave it for at least 5 minutes before disposing, never re-light it!
- Keep a garden hose or bucket of water nearby to extinguish any stray sparks.
- Burns are serious injuries, in case of **emergency call 911!**
